

POLICY ON THE PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT OF FOOD WASTE AND LOSS COLOMBINA BUSINESS GROUP

Colombina Business Group is committed to reducing food waste and loss. Measures have been established to reduce these phenomena through sustainable food systems, social inclusion, environmental sustainability and economic development - all to positively impact food security and overall nutrition.

To this end, Colombina Business Group created its Policy on Food Waste and Loss. This policy puts in motion loss-and-waste prevention measures in production, distribution, handling, storage, marketing and consumption processes.

To accomplish this goal, Colombina implements production-plant use and loss reduction measures, which both prevent the waste of food intended for human consumption, as well as fosters optimization of supply-chain processes to contribute to sustainable development, social inclusion and environmental sustainability.

Reducing food waste or loss will be achieved as follows:

- Promote and strengthen Sustainable Development Goals issued by the UN, particularly for "Zero Hunger" and "Responsible Production and Consumption".
- Promote and strengthen procedures to prevent and reduce both the loss and the management of waste and raw material scraps generated during production processes.
- Promote and strengthen its Comprehensive Industrial-waste-and-surplus Management Program for reduction, at-source separation, re-use or re-incorporation on animal-feed lines and recycling.
- Implement product-donation measures for those involved in food production and the marketing chain.
- Develop and promote educational campaigns for Colombina employees and its other interest groups that impart knowledge and awareness of the importance of adopting measures geared toward the reduction and suitable at-source management necessary to mitigate food waste and loss.
- Strengthen and promote public disclosure on Colombina's progress.
